



Calling All Bakers for Weekend of Wallkill's Apple Pie Baking Contest

Contestants will have the opportunity to show off their favorite family recipe and participate in an old-fashioned, Blue-Ribbon competition during the Weekend of Wallkill, sponsored by Vision of Wallkill. So dig out your favorite apple pie recipe, or start making one now. You may be Wallkill's Best Apple Pie Baker.

1. The Apple Pie Baking Contest is open to all individual, amateur bakers residing in the Town of Shawangunk and/or Wallkill Central School District. Limit 1 entry per person. An amateur baker is one who enjoys baking for family and friends and not for salary, nor is a professional baker, cook, or chef.
2. All contest entries must be submitted between 10 and 11 am on Saturday September 24, 2022 to the Vision of Wallkill tent on the Wallkill Public Library Lawn. Please complete the entry form at the bottom of Page 2 and bring with your entry and recipe. All items become property of Vision of Wallkill once dropped off for judging.
3. Make your pie with *local, Hudson Valley* apples. We recommend your pie crust and filling are homemade from scratch. The entire pie, including any decorations must be edible. Single, double, lattice crusts or other crust styles are acceptable.
4. Traditional apple pies only. No betties, crumbles, cakes, turnovers, etc. Do not include other fruits such as pears, raisins, peaches, berries, etc. or nuts in your submission.
5. Each entry must be one full pie and submitted for judging in a food-safe, disposable pan. (All pans, plates and dishes are considered to be disposable and will not be returned.) Pies must be uncut and be presented in their normal circular form representing an 8 or 9" pie plate. A bakery box will be provided when you drop off your pie to keep fresh while waiting for judging. Pies will not be refrigerated, so plan appropriately.
6. The recipe for the pie and pie crust must be submitted with your entry on an 8 ½" by 11" sheet of paper. The recipe must be typed and list all the ingredients, quantities, and preparation instructions for your recipe along with the entrant's name, home address, phone number and email address on the backside of all the pages. If the recipe is not your own, please reference your source. If the recipe is a family secret, include ingredients and the type of apples used. All recipes and pies will become the property of Vision of Wallkill and will not be returned. Recipes may be used for future publication.



7. By entering, you give permission to have your photo taken and published in all media outlets used for promotional materials for Vision of Walkkill and its Apple Pie Baking Contest. You also agree to allow us to publish your winning recipe.
8. Vision of Walkkill reserves the right to disqualify participants who do not follow the rules or whose entries do not fit the nature of the competition.
9. Judging will be based on presentation, taste, texture, creativity:

Flavor	30 points
Filling: consistency, doneness, moistness & flavor	25 points
Crust: color, flavor, texture doneness	20 points
Overall Appearance	15 points
Creativity	10 points
TOTAL	100 points

10. Winners will be announced at 2:30 pm. Prizes and/or ribbons will be awarded to winning entries. Any winners present for the announcement will have their photos taken and receive their awards.

First-, second- and third-place winners will be announced for Best Tasting Pie. A fourth winner will be chosen for Most Beautiful Pie.
