

Terms and Conditions for Popp Park Yard Sale Spaces Town-Wide Yard April 29, 2023

- 1. This is a family-friendly event. All items must be family-friendly.
- 2. Applications will be accepted on a First come First served basis and will be notified if spaces have been filled. Your space is not confirmed until payment is received.
- 3. Vendors with outside spaces must provide their own tables, chairs, tents.
- 4. Vendors with inside spaces will be provided 1 picnic table to display items. They will have 2 feet of floor space on each end of the table. Please bring your own chair for seating.
- 5. Setup begins at 7:30. Breakdown begins at 3pm.
- 6. Participants will operate at a minimum from 9:00am to 3:00pm. Participants may stay later, but spaces must be cleaned up and offsite by 4:00pm.
- 7. Participants will take all unsold items, boxes, trash etc. with them at the end of the day. Trash receptacles will not be provided, and all spaces are expected to be returned to pre-existing conditions.
- 8. No smoking is allowed in the vending area.
- 9. No pets are allowed.
- 10. Mask and social distancing requirements will follow state mandates/requirements in place on the day of the event.

The Town-Wide Yard Sale will be advertised by Vision of Wallkill on our Facebook and Instagram pages, www.visionofwallkill.com, in the Wallkill Valley Times, and other local websites and social media pages.
