
## 'Jean Jean 'Rigole Jean L. A. (RAF n° 156375)

Born on 6 June 1920 at Laeken. Sgt Pilot with 11/5/1Aé before War. Evaded from Belgium and arrived in Great Britain on 20 June 1941. Enlisted in to Belgian Section of the RAF on 14 July 1941 as Sergeant. Send to SFTS on 26 July 1941 and to 58 OTU on 24 October 1941. Posted to 124 Sqn on 23 December 1941. Transfered to 350 Sqn on 16 June 1942. Promoted to W/O on 2 May 1943, posted to RAF Depot N°1 on 6 December 1943, F/O on 30 December 1943. Joined the Holding Unit on 20 January 1944. Returned to 350 Sqn on 22 May 1944 for non-flying duties. Joined the Belgian Training School on 23 November 1944 and the School for Administration and Accountancy on 28 March 1945. Died in a plane crash at Beausart on 24 February 1952 flying Spitfire 14 n° SG38.
