HOW SPECIAL ARE TOTAL SOLAR ECLIPSES?

Besides being incredibly already rare in frequency, several decades can pass before another total eclipse visits the same location. In New Brunswick's example, the last Total Solar Eclipse was in 1972 and even back then it only visited a small portion of the northeast corner of the province.

The real reason is the visceral experience you'll live as the Moon begins to journey across the face of the Sun. Slowly the sky begins to dim, and as they both begin to align almost perfectly, you don't just notice almost night-like darkness but the temperature cooling as well. The wildlife begins to act as if it is nightfall, including total silence from usually vocal animals like birds, an obvious sign that something amazing is happening.

For avid astronomers, astrophotographers, photographers, the opportunity to capture the three sequences of the totality.

It begins from the corona (diamond ring), then Bailey's beads to the final corona which is the only time you can see with your own eyes the Sun's most outwardly layer.

The sun's atmosphere has a ring of white to the yellow haze around the edge of the Moon and the expected time of totality will be around 2 minutes.

What an amazing experience you'll remember for the rest of your life and most a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity!






When the great complete solar eclipse visits New Brunswick on April 8th, 2024, it will have been more than 52 years since the previous complete solar eclipse visited our province. Back in 1972 it only passed through a small portion of the province coming across the picturesque Acadian Peninsula in the Northeastern section of the province. The eclipse will be by all accounts the most special celestial event in Eastern Canada, if not, all of Canada. It will cross from West to East nearly in the central region of New Brunswick as this presents a very accessible event as most people will be fewer than 60 minutes from the path of totality. Thusmaking New Brunswick the most attractive jurisdiction in all of Canada for this important once-in-a-lifetime celestial event for most people!

Doaktown is a beautiful rural community in central New Brunswick along the upper valley of the powerful and beautiful Miramichi River. It provides the perfect location as it will sit within a handful of kilometers from the centre of the path of totality of the complete solar eclipse path. The area is sought by avid eclipse chasers from around the world, avid amateur and professional astronomers, and photographers to observe and capture that so rare moment.

Where, the eclipse reaches its corona which is when the Moon completely covers the disc of the Sun just allowing that so very magnificent halo of light all around the edge of the cosmic embrace both discs share for several seconds. This presents the climax of the entire process that progresses in a little more than a couple of hours. Doaktown's real strength does not only rely on its fortuitous location on the map as one of New Brunswick's most famed regions with its beautiful nature.





He also enjoys other aspects of the natural world, such as Dragonflies, Butterflies & Moths He holds his Explore the Universe Certificate from the Royal Astronomical Society of Canada.

Lisa Ann Fanning was born in New York City, and has lived in Massachusetts before settling down in New Jersey. She has been birding for over 13 years, but appreciated the natural world long before that. With a strong interest in Marine Sciences, she gravitated toward helping monitor endangered shorebirds at the Jersey Shore and is a naturalist for the American Littoral Society. She is an amateur astronomer who prides herself on inspiring new astronomers and the curious to "Look Up!" as part of her "Lisa's Look Up!" Facebook page. She is the newsletter editor for RASC Halifax's Nova Notes and currently holds observing certificates for Explore the Universe and Explore the Moon.
