## TRAVEL INFORMATION – APRIL 26<sup>th</sup> (FRIDAY)


ATHLETE ARRIVAL: All Varsity athletes should plan on arriving at the House One bus loop no later than 12:20 PM on Friday afternoon.

BUS DEPARTURE:The two buses will depart promptly at 12:30 PM from House One. Coach Shyne<br/>will be on the Varsity Girls bus and Coach Andrews will be on the Varsity Boys bus.<br/>The buses will be going to site to rig the boats and then proceeding to the hotel.

BUS RETURN: We will depart the regatta site on Saturday once the last Varsity boat for Fayetteville-Manlius has raced, and the trailer is loaded.

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

VENUE RULES: The event is held at the State Boat Launch at Lee's Park in Saratoga Springs, NY (see the site maps below). Bus/onsite car parking will be limited to the shell trailer tow vehicle plus two pre-purchased team vehicle passes per team. All other parking will be at the Saratoga Casino (see map below) with shuttle service available to and from the regatta venue. The shuttle is 5-minute ride from the venue and will run from 06:00 AM to 07:00 PM on Saturday. While there will be no fee to park offsite, there will be a \$5 fee to ride the shuttle. DO NOT park in Lee's Park if you do not have one of the two pre-purchased team passes as you will not be allowed entry and may be towed.

A reminder that Lee's Park is a privately owned property, so please do not go on the property to spectate. If you do, volunteers or Saratoga Rowing Association staff will ask to you please leave (and if you get caught by the owners of Lee's Park, they will <u>not</u> ask nicely.)

- DRONE COVERAGE: The regatta will have livestream drone coverage, both for viewing at the regatta and online. There will be a large tent by the vendor area that will have enough tables and chairs for teams and spectators to gather and watch the drone video.
- FOOD / MEALS: Athletes will be provided dinner on Friday evening and breakfast Saturday morning at the hotel, along with lunch on Saturday at the racecourse. Additional money for food should not be necessary unless they want to make a purchase while traveling to/from the regatta or at the racecourse. However, when the buses are traveling, we are going to try to limit the number of stops the buses make so that we can get there in a timely manner. There will be at least one stop each way for a restroom/snack break, but we will not be stopping for meals.
