The Contractor agrees to furnish the labor, materials, and supplies necessary to perform the Services in accordance with the terms and conditions contained in this Agreement. Upon completion of the Services, the Contractor will remove all materials, supplies, and other debris.

**2. Changes in the Services.** The Customer may request reasonable changes to the Services described in Section 1. Any changes to the Services must be in writing and signed by both the Contractor and the Customer. The Customer agrees that any changes to the Services may result in additional charges and extend the Construction Schedule described in Section 3.

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The contractor generally requests subcontractor services because they cannot perform the service on their own. This is usually for major transactions, such as plumbing, electricity, blood, carpentry, internal design or any service the contractor decides to hire. Type (8) Hiring a construction subcontractor before a contractor can hire a subcontractor, will first have to conclude a customer service agreement. Once the agreement is concluded (high-risk contract), the contractor will be aware of the timetable, volume and workload for the entire project. The contractor will have to coordinate with the subcontractor the timetable, responsibilities and obligations to carry out its tasks in relation to the entire project. Step 1 The subcontractor signs a non-disclosure agreement before most subcontractors even count on the agreement, they will have to see plans between the contractor and the client. The subcontractor should generally authorize a non-disclosure agreement indicating that any plan it considers will remain confidential. The contractor then usually accepts subcontractors' requests for work. Step 2 The subcontractor will need to know the exact specifications of what the client and contractor are trying to build. This is often known as "working inversion" institutes, which provides essential materials and constructions. The subcontractor may evaluate and submit a request to the contractor in the hope of obtaining employment among other subcontractors seeking the same employment. Step 3 The contractor and the subcontractor shall examine the details and obligations of the agreement. This will require both parties to agree who will be responsible for the personnel, materials, equipment, travel and any other duty of the parties. In addition, mention should be made of the way the subcontractor is paid. If the time, work or combination of work plus the percentage of materials used, the subcontractor may start working from the start date specified in the agreement. Step 4 The subcontractor shall be legally obliged to provide the services specified in the subcontractor. If not, it may have legal and financial implications, as the contractor places on the services to complete the entire project. In the case of change orders which are requests by the contractor or the contracting entity that change the agreement, the negotiations of these changes are in accordance with the agreement. This usually consists of at most 3-5 working days or the agreement can be terminated. Video Updated on 08.
