What is hospice?

With pain and symptom management, as well as education and support, patients and families are able to focus on what is truly important when life matters most.

Hospice is not a place, but a philosophy of care. It is a unique health care approach in which the patient and family are the focus, not the disease. Hospice care helps patients and their families make the most of the time that remains.

Hospice is a team of specially trained healthcare professionals caring for the patient and relieving anxiety for the caregiver and family. Our hospice support team helps patients manage pain and symptoms, while also providing social, emotional, spiritual and grief support for them and their loved ones. Hospice brings comfort and quality to the remaining months, weeks and days.

Who is eligible for hospice care?

Hospice care is for people who have a life-limiting illness with a life expectancy of six months or less and have chosen to focus on comfort care over treatment. Our hospice team works with each patient and their family to develop a plan of care tailored to their disease and individual needs.

Where is hospice care provided?

Because hospice is a plan of care, not a place, patients may receive hospice care wherever they call home. When medically necessary, our services are also available to hospitalized individuals.

Who provides hospice care?

Our hospice teams are highly skilled professionals and community resources, including nurses, aides, social workers, spiritual counselors, physicians and volunteers, who provide care that address the specific needs, wishes and values of each patient and their family.

Who pays for hospice care?

Hospice is covered under the Medicare Hospice Benefit (MHB), most Medicaid plans and many private insurance plans. Most plans cover hospice care and the medications, medical supplies and medical equipment related to the hospice prognosis.
