<u>Check Stealing:</u> Paper checks can be stolen from mailboxes and the ink is washed off with chemicals. A new amount is then filled and a new payee. Now thieves are taking a digital picture of stolen checks and then altering them by using commercially available software. Criminals then prints new phony check or deposit it using a banks mobile app.

How to stay safe: Send bills and money by electronic transfers from your bank. If you do want to send checks drop them off at the nearest post office instead of using a neighborhood mailbox. Continually monitor your checking account.

<u>Voice Printing:</u> New technological advances allow thieves to capture a recording of your voice and let them impersonate you. That voiceprint can be used to access your financial institution. They can request funds be transferred to an account they control.

How to stay safe: Do not have phone conversations with anyone other than family and close friends. Calls that look like a familiar number could be coming from a stolen phone.
