We are so saddened for the many good soulwinning fundamental Baptist churches that are affected. Please pray for Pastor Jeff Owens, Twin River Baptist Church, it is located in New Bern. New Bern has suffered extensive flooding. Also Pastor Griffin, Fellowship Baptist Church are in Wilmington, NC. Pastor Swiatocho has his church right near the beaches just south of Wilmington. Pastor Couch is just north of Wilmington and Pastor Butler, Peoples Baptist Church, Greenville NC, Pastor Schneider, Westside Baptist Church in Laurinburg NC. Pray also for our son Cary and his family as they live south of Raleigh.

School started in June in the Philippines. At the moment we have 8 highschoolers taking RBC Bible Institute classes on Tues/Thurs evenings. They are not up on their English and it is difficult for them, but are keeping at it. They included 2 of our national pastor's boys, 2 are children of members at FBC and 4 children of members at RBC. They all stay on our compound. Pray that they will grasp English better and learn so they will grow in the Lord and truth of the Bible. Unfortunately, a lady that worked overseas and financially supported most of the ministry did not like what he had done. Now he is able to help Pastor Jr at First Baptist in building it back up. Rick meet Peter, an American who married Susan, a Philipina, and moved close by.
