Here in Tocantins we have entered the hot, dry season, and temperatures will average around 100 until the middle of November, with practically no rainfall. Since houses here have no central a/c, it can get uncomfortably hot at home. Thankfully we do have split units in the office and bedrooms which we leave on for a few hours at night.



Missions Conference Attendance

Ministry-wise we are thankful that things **have** begun to "heat up" in the new work here in Palmas. At the end of July the Independent Baptist Church in Palmas held its first Faith Promise Missions Conference. Our services averaged 25 in attendance with several first time visitors. We are please to report that the new church promised \$140.00 per month to missions. This will allow us to pick up some more missionaries, adding to the two that we already support, as well as help with some special missionary projects during the year.

We are also thankful that our average weekly attendance has increased as a new family

has started coming to services. We now have four families attending regularly. Although we have not seen any public professions of faith, we are encouraged by the increased attendance, as well as the consistent canvassing we have been able to do. God has allowed us to cover 11 city blocks and hand out almost 7500 tracts/invitations, 4000 of those since our missions conference. Please pray that we will stay faithful to the Lord and encouraged as the seed is planted and the Gospel is preached.



Please pray as well for the prayer ministry that I am having with some local businessmen every two weeks. We will be hosting a breakfast for them on September 15, with the hope of presenting them with the Gospel.
