Dear Ones in Christ,

"Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom... Then saith he unto his disciples, The harvest truly is plenteous, but the laborers are few; Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he will send forth laborers into his harvest." - Matthew 9:35-38. We are to pray for laborers as we - like Nehemiah of old - build and battle for the Kingdom of God. With a sword in one hand and a trowel in the other, staying faithful on our part of the wall until it is finished!

Revival week in Kiev, Ukraine: Our song leader, who also speaks Russian, and I spent a week in Kiev at a conference. Many were saved, baptized and revived for the kingdom. One evening we visited a Messianic Church (converted Jews to Christianity). It was exciting to see their hunger for the things of God and devotion to Jesus. Much prayer and fasting went into the preparation of those meetings. We want this fire in Germany was our prayer together!

Wedding in August: I performed the ceremony for a Hungarian man and German woman. Great time together and fellowship with the families and friends. Some were not saved and it was a good opportunity to share the love of Christ with precious people. We still believe that marriage is ordained of God only for a man and a woman and teach it that way here. Amen!

Gypsy preacher: In September a friend of ours who is a gypsy preached for us on being filled with the Holy Spirit. His grandfather was the only one of his relatives to survive Nazi concentration camps in World War Two. He was nervous standing in front of the German congregation but the power and presence of God was there!

First motorcycle service: There are several motorcycle riders in the church and some of the ladies have spouses that ride. I met a young man who is a motorcycle evangelist and invited him to speak. Over 50 bikes showed up and packed out the morning service. A lot of non-christian men were there. Great evangelistic preaching, a beautiful ride through the hills and super BBQ at the end. We are already planning for next year!

Baptism: The first Sunday of October we baptized a German couple, a German man and an Iranian refugee who had to flee Iran after he converted to Christianity. One of the saved Iranian men in the church who has a German wife helped to translate and to baptize. A former Muslim refugee is helping to baptize Germans in Germany. Is that not cool or what? I love serving our great God!

Bible Conference: We just had our annual Bible Conference with the largest attendance we have ever had in this church building. There was great teaching on letting Jesus live through us in His power and revealing God's love and glory in the body of Christ. Many lives were impacted. Our son Chuck and his wife Abigail flew in from the States to be a vital help in this meeting. Thank you kids. We are in this together!

Thank you!: It is a great time to be alive and living for Jesus Christ. We are honored to serve with each of you in making a difference and bringing real light and life to souls here in Germany. Please keep on praying for us. It is a spiritual war and not a time to give up! Thank you!
