Prayer, Praise & Progress Report - April 2019

Dear Ones in Christ,

"Now there are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit. And there are differences of administrations, but the same Lord. And there are diversities of operations, but it is the same God which worketh all in all. But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal. We have been preaching and teaching this year that our triune God is building His church by calling His children into active participation in His work and equipping them for the work of ministering to others in His body. We grow as we minister in community and there are no Lone Rangers in this Kingdom!

Baptism: We just baptized five people in the town swimming pool. They gave testimony of leaving the old life behind and trusting Jesus now as their King and Savior. As the early church practiced if there is deliverance needed we do that and encourage the ones being baptized to be filled with the Holy Spirit. Start them out right. Even the pool life guard was singing along with "Amazing Grace". A lady from town who is not a member of our church gave witness in the following Sunday service that she had severe back pains and went swimming just after we baptized. She reported that all the pain left her and then was told we had just baptized in the pool. Baptism is a great testimony - Amen!

Children's work: The children's ministry training in February was led by a family in full time ministry and went great with about 20 participants present. The training will continue and is necessary as more children are coming out to church. On the following Sunday we had a Family Service led by the children's ministry family. Tremendous! The adults had as much fun singing action children songs as the kids did. It is great to see Germans enjoying church! Not religion but relationship with Jesus!

USA visit: In March Tricia and I visited my parents for two weeks. They are 90 years old and it was great connecting with them. I told my Dad I was proud of him and loved him. The German church gave us a gift to cover the plane fare. It seems a majority of Germans do not have a good father relationship and I see that it impacts on them not being able to trust the Heavenly Father. That will change and they will learn to trust our good Abba-Father! I love ministering to these people and leading them to experience that!

Team building: In the church we are building teams where the believers can walk out their calling from God and minister to others. The recent Bible conference in April was directed at that and many responded to where they felt God has equipped and called them to minister. It seems there will be an increase coming and God is preparing for it. Do I live my life in the presence of God and for His purpose? I want to say yes!

International Sunday: This Sunday we will be celebrating the diversity of nations in our church. Twelve birth nations will be presented with testimonies of blessings and thanks. Afterwards there will be an international dinner and songs. More and people are coming to us and saying our church feels like a family where love is present. We want more of that in John 13:35!
