


Serving in East Africa

We had a full day planned where I would be preaching several times and then a meal with everyone to end the day. We found out that the city of Eldoret (where we live), had planned a marathon for Easter Sunday and many of the roads would be closed down as a result of the race. Early Sunday morning I went out and scoped a route we could take to get through town and out towards the village. But when we left as a family a little later on in the morning we found that all the roads that were previously opened had been closed down! We weren't able to make it more than 100 yards from our house before we were blocked off by police. We tried to go down other back roads, but to no avail. We finally returned home about an hour later were we had to have an improvised service! The rest of April thankfully, has not been like Easter Sunday!

I have been able to teach at a Medical University several times this month to a group of believers and some nonbelievers. It is a joy to speak with students after the class and answer questions and continue in conversation about the lesson. As the month of May approaches I am preparing to travel fly to Turkana(North Western Kenya) and then Mombasa (Eastern Coast) to teach in the Bible schools and in a pastors conference. Please pray for safety in traveling to these areas, pray that we will be begin to see much spiritual fruit and be an encouragement to those who will attend. Please also be in prayer for the other Bible schools I will be teaching at in Nandi, Eldoret, and Kitale. The purpose of our being in Kenya is to primarily train and equip young men to do the work of the ministry. That training happens both in and out of the classroom. Pray that God continues to raise up young Kenyan men and women to serve Him here in Eastern Africa.
