The team ministered to 1,010 patients with over 54 hours of hard work. Of these, **310** souls confessed the Lord Jesus Christ as Saviour. A total of **five** Christian Laymen Assisting International Missionaries (CLAIM) construction mission trips have occurred since February with **one** profession of faith. Praise the Lord!

My April CLAIM mission trip to Antigua, West Indies, proved to be very productive. I wish to thank the team for their hard work as we maneuvered through various obstacles. The team was able to put on most of the roof for Maranatha Baptist Church and Pastor Jerome Martin. Our only regret is that we were not completely able to finish the project in our allotted time, but the project was left at the point where the nationals who helped us could finish it.

My next two CLAIM mission trips this summer will include Glenda. We are excited about going to Alaska to help our BIMI missionary Pat McCoy with "labor of love" projects in three villages. This will be Glenda's first trip to help in Alaska.

Our second trip includes three weeks of ministry in the Philippines. Harvest Baptist Church of San Juan City, Manila, Philippines, is the church we established with the help of our two oldest children, Melissa and Joey. To my understanding, Harvest Baptist Church has started five other church outreach ministries. To God be the glory, great things He is doing! Pastor Edgar Pojas has invited us back for the dedication of the new building that the church family at Harvest Baptist Church has erected. Several of you had a financial part in this new building. To you we say, "THANK YOU!" The Lord used you to make this project become a reality.

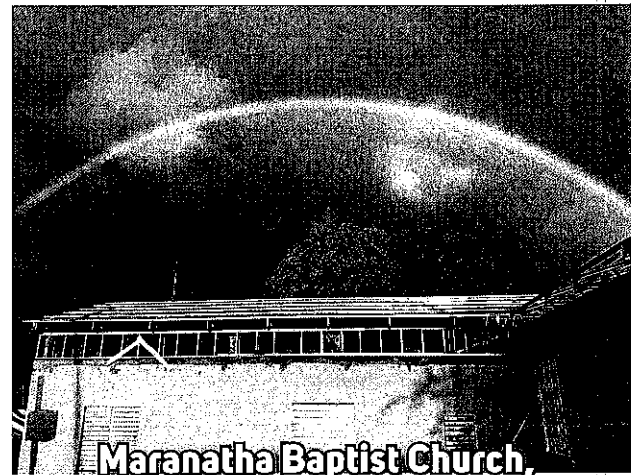

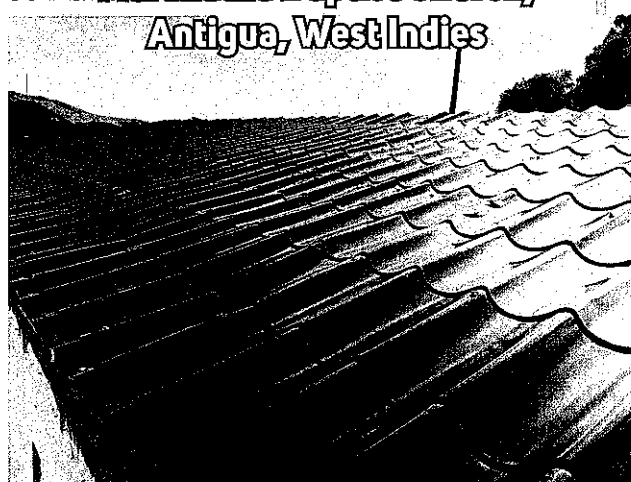
