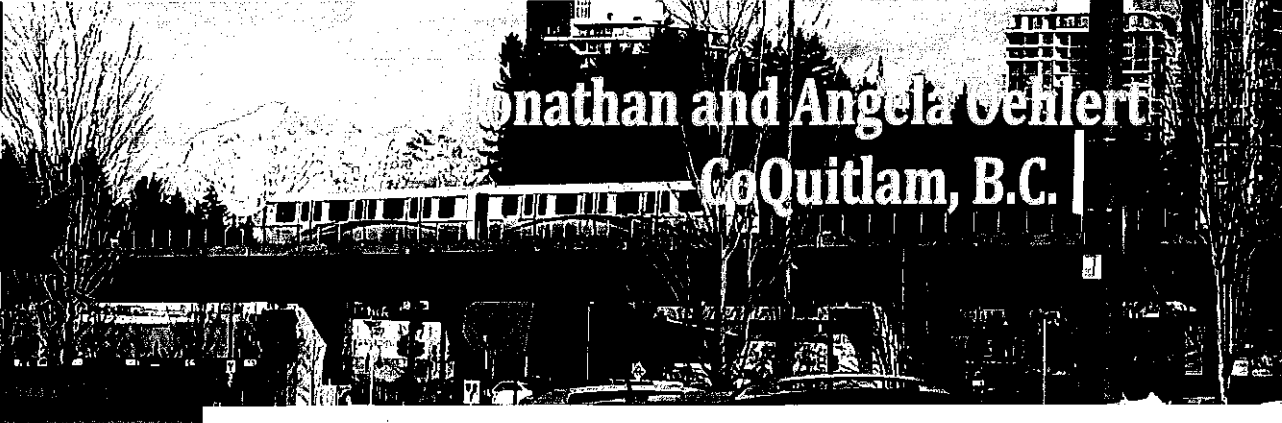




Jonathan and Angela Oehlert Coquitlam, B.C.

Later, a church in Maryland paid the full cost of renting the hall!



Dr. Barry and Cheryl Webb did an amazing job ministering the Word of God using puppets to tell Bible stories, providing music specials to prepare hearts, using chalk art to tell the gospel, and teaching and preaching the Word to their appropriate audiences. We did not ever have large crowds;



however, several people who are not yet believers heard the gospel. An immigrant family from Guatemala attended one evening. In the children's class, their seven-year-old son asked very thoughtful questions. He asked, "So, what is the Bible anyway?" He also inquired, "So, let me get this, is Jesus His own father?" He got a lot of questions answered. Pray that Alex Jr. will be able to receive more of the gospel.

Recently, there was sad news about an accident in which a young Asian girl was killed. Evidently, one car hit another pushing it up on a median where students were waiting to cross the street. I recently met Hannah, one of the girl's older sisters. While I was unable to speak to her directly because of the circumstances of the event where we met, I was able to give Hannah a very good gospel tract and note.



One of the church members I have been discipling, told me that a family member had called him for prayer about a problem. This family member has attended church meetings and has heard the gospel. She had always let on that she was a Christian and would be offended if she was challenged on the fact. During the phone call, our church member was able to challenge his family member with the fact that her sin had not been dealt with and that she had not accepted Jesus Christ as her Saviour.
