I am pleased to report that we have had a consistent stream of visitors since our church anniversary this year. Several have come in due to our website. Several others were return visitors from several years ago. Several Chinese have visited off and on. Mr. Wang had visited for two weeks back in 2010 as a single man. He came in with his wife and son to check us out again. A lady that I think is Chinese has ducked in for service periodically but leaves promptly at noon without talking to anyone. Wayne has been the most consistent addition, having attended 4 out of the last five weeks. He visited three years ago. He is a Christian and said that he has been distracted and following some paths that have not been good. He really has been eating up the strong Bible teaching. The most interesting growth is in our mid-week service. In the third year of our ministry, the attendance for the mid-week prayer and Bible study was nearly that of our Sunday attendance. However, after a great number of people moved from our area, the attendance was a pittance of what it had been. I was trying not to be discouraged, and tried to give the same amount of prayer, energy, and study to that service. We have had several new people begin to attend the mid-week service, which thrills my soul.

Another thrill to my soul is when someone accepts Christ as Savior. Recently, I heard that a person that I had been praying for and witnessing to had secretly become a Christian. We have seen a definite change in the person. A couple of weeks ago, the Lord led me to speak to a fellow who was sitting in some shade to avoid the sun. It happened that Rich knew a lot of the gospel but had never personalized it. He received Christ as Saviour. After I added a few things, as I prepared to go, Rich said, "I needed a messenger from God today."

As I close this letter, I would just ask for prayer on three things:

- 1) That God would direct us in our raising of our boys [Pray too that the spiritual growth that I have seen in Micaiah, though he is so young, would continue.];
- 2) That Angela and I would have the rest, health, energy, and wisdom that we need for the many responsibilities before us;
- 3) That the church plant here would have the space and workers to grow.
