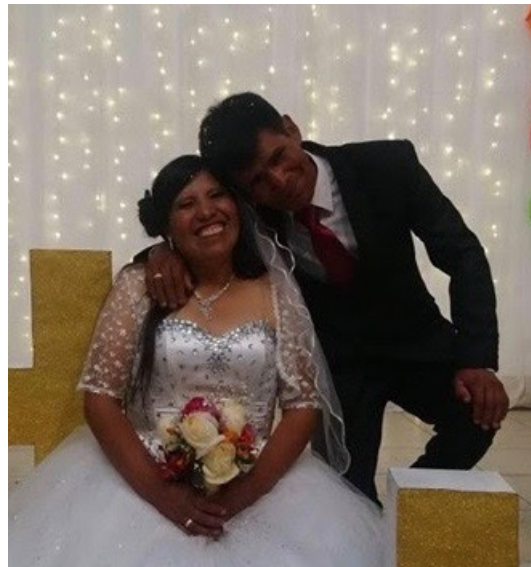

It has been VERY cold here in Urubamba the last few weeks. The temperature goes way down at nights. Usually it warms up during the day but this year there have been many cloudy, cold days as well.

Several exciting activities have kept us extremely busy for the last 4 months. We appreciate your prayers. We could feel them.

Mother's day was an exciting event. Several ladies helped with make picture frames out of noodles and it was a blessing to see several visitors present for the event.

Beth's parents (David and Heidi Racke) came down the beginning of June and we had a wonderful week of rest and really enjoyed being with them again.

The month of July has truly been eventful. The 6 of July we celebrated the wedding of a dear friend who has been in the church since we got here 10 years ago. There were over 400 people at the wedding who clearly heard the gospel preached at that event.

A week later the Medical Campaign began. It was the first time we had done anything like this and boy! Was it an adventure. A team of 30 US young people, 7 Peruvian dentists, a Peruvian pharmacist, and a doctor and 2 nurses from Bolivia, and at least 4 missionary units, participated in the event. In total over 1,700 people heard the gospel and around 29 made professions of faith. Please pray that the gospel will bring forth lasting fruit. Pray as we visit those who had interest in further discussion.

After those monumental projects, we are now geared for the end of the year.

Please pray for the children as they finish 1-3 John in September. September is also the anniversary for the church. October we will be doing a special 4-day conference with the Quechua ministry as well as the Seminary anniversary. Many are expected to attend.

School continues and construction on a new kindergarten building at Heroes of Faith that will serve as home for the 3-5 year olds. The existing building will be used as room for elementary school next year. Pray for the salvation of many of the students in the Christian school who come from terrible family situations. Our homeschool group continues strong and it is a blessing to see the students maturing and desiring to serve Christ.

On the home front, Bethany is now teaching English at the Christian school as well as teaching the beginning English students in our English class at home. She is very creative and is always surprising us with her creativity. Joey and Jordan continue to enjoy soccer and Emily livens our home with her antics. Samuel keeps very busy with his triple responsibilities (church, seminary, home) and very recently the permissions for the medical campaign. Beth continues to teach and accomplish the various projects that come her way. Please pray for our family. God has been very good to us. Pray that we will be faithful and that we would obey and do what God wants us to do.
