We are thankful that we can be useful in this important endeavor.

In addition to our Bible Institute ministry, I am also preaching in several of our churches here, praying to be a help and encouragement to the pastors and churches.

We also continue to pray and wait on the Lord to open doors for us to help the churches here start preaching points and open new congregations. Since this is such an important ministry (indeed our primary ministry here is to plant churches), the devil fights and discourages those who pursue it. Please pray with us as we work and encourage the local churches here to enlarge the place of their tents, stretch forth the curtains of their habitations, lengthen their cords, and strengthen their stakes. We have so little time left and so much work to accomplish, and the need is so great.
