

Dear Praying Friends,

Paul wrote, "God is faithful, by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord." (1 Cor. 1:9) Since we last wrote we have continued to experience our Father's faithfulness in various aspects of our ministry here in Ukraine. In January's general session of Slavic Baptist

Institute, we saw a number of new students with a good group of returning students who came ready to hear from God. One of our new enrolling students was deaf. In May we will have our Spring session of SBI, as well as graduation. Please continue in prayer for our deaf student body, for the Lord to call more new students to join us, and for our student body, in general, to continue growing in grace and in the knowledge of the Lord.

We have also experienced the Lord's faithfulness at Living Hope Baptist Church of Kyiv. In December we held a special service to celebrate Christmas and take opportunity to share the true purpose and Person of Christmas. It was a wonderful time in which we have some who have faithfully visited services since. We have begun a new study in Romans with the hope that the Lord will pierce the darkness of the works-based gospel that shrouds Ukrainian people and give understanding of justification by grace through faith alone in Christ alone. We are seeing the Lord call out a body of believers and we deeply covet your prayers for the Lord to build a strong and living assembly that will hold forth the "word of life" in Kyiv and the regions beyond.

The Lord's faithfulness is not limited to our past, and encourages us with opportunities in the future. In March we will hold our next session of SBI Advanced. The theme for our upcoming graduate program will be Missiology. Dr. Dwight Tomlinson (Barnabas 10/40) and other guests will be teaching and sharing their burdens for a gospel starved world. At our session's conclusion, SBI will be sponsoring a national mission conference (March 27-28) in Kyiv. We are inviting pastors, young people, and churches to come from all parts of Ukraine. Please join us in praying for eyes to be opened and hearts burdened for world evangelism. Ukrainian churches have great potential and much to offer to this end. One has said, "You can trust God with tomorrow because he was faithful with yesterday." This truth reassures us that we can ardently trust in our Lord's faithfulness and pray "that he will send forth laborers into his harvest."


