

Dear parents,

Please note that once more NEITHER our buses NOR the tram lines 4, 17, 18 and S2 will be affected by the GDL's current strike call for the period from 24 to 29 January.

However, there may be disruptions on KVV lines S31, S32, S4, S5, S51, S52, S6, S7, S71, S8 and S81 as well as VRN lines (e.g. line S9 Mannheim - Graben-Neudorf - Karlsruhe). Details can be found

If your child normally uses one of the affected lines on the way to school and you plan to take them by car on the strike days, the P&R car park at the "Hagsfeld Fächerbad" stop may be an option to avoid the increased traffic volume in the Europaviertel before the start of lessons. From the "Hagsfeld Fächerbad" stop, the trams largely run every 5 minutes before the start of lessons and only take 8 minutes to get to school:

- At 7:22 a.m. Line 4
- At 7:32 a.m. Line 4
- At 7:37 a.m. Line 17
- At 7:42 a.m. Line 4
- At 7:47 a.m. Line 18

The "Hagsfeld Fächerbad" stop has many parking spaces in the immediate vicinity and is much better accessible for car traffic than the Europaviertel.
