Booster Club Pass

AKA: Sports Pass/TNBC Membership Pass

Each year Tiger Nation Booster Club (TNBC) sells hundreds of Family and Individual Booster Club Passes. It is a great fundraiser for our schools and a great option for families and Tiger Nation fans. Learn more about what the Booster Club pass is and how it works!

What is a booster club pass?

The pass can be used for admission at all **regular season HOME** games at Eisenhower Middle School (EMS), Eisenhower High School (EHS), Goddard Middle School (GMS), and Goddard High School (GHS). Even if you don't plan to attend south-side events, when Eisenhower is the VISITOR at Goddard's HOME games, passes can be used for admission during the regular season. The Goddard Lion Booster Club sells the same pass to their families and supporters. The pass also automatically includes you as a member of the TNBC.

Where can I use the booster club pass?

Most sports at EMS and EHS have admission/gate fees. The pass allows access to the regular season HOME games that charge admission. In most cases tennis, golf, cross country, and track do not charge admission fees, but are always included in TNBC activities and their teams, along with other activities and clubs, are supported financially by TNBC.

What pass options are available and how much do they cost?

- **\$150 Gold Membership**
 - Four or more immediate family members (1-2 parents and 1-6 *dependents)
- **\$120 White Membership**
 - Three people in an immediate family (2 parents and 1 *dependent or 1 parent and 2 *dependents)
- **\$100 Black Membership**
 - Two immediate family members (2 parents or 2 *dependents or a combo of 1 parent and 1 *dependent)
- **\$50 Blue Membership**
 - Individual membership (1 person, child-age 64)
- **\$30 Senior Membership**
 - Individual senior/grandparent (1 person, age 65+)
- **\$25 Bronze Membership**
 - Membership in TNBC, no pass
- **\$5 Replacement Per Card if lost**

*Dependents are all children (child-college senior) in your immediate family. Each pass sold is for one individual and is not intended to be shared.

How does the pass support our schools?

ONE HUNDRED PERCENT of the proceeds from the sale of passes goes to TNBC. TNBC raises money throughout the school year through the sale of passes, merchandise, food at TNBC events, special events--such as the Golf Tourney, business sponsorships, etc. TNBC donates all the money raised back to EMS and EHS which is used to financially support a variety of clubs, activities, and sports.
