Accident and Emergency Procedure

- Stay calm, act swiftly and observe the situation.
- Is there danger of further injury?
- Listen to what the injured person is saying.
- Alert the first-aider who should take appropriate action for minor injuries. At training sessions all coaching staff and the Training Night Assistant is first aid qualified. On match nights the Team Manager is first aid qualified.
- On training nights the first aid kit is located at the court side and held by the Team Manager on game nights.
- Please ensure that you have taken all necessary safeguards for your own personal safety before you start administering first aid i.e. wear surgical gloves which can be located in the first aid kit.

ACCIDENT & EMERGENCY POLICY

 In the event of an injury requiring specialist treatment, call the emergency services. • Deal with the rest of the group and ensure that they are adequately supervised.

- Do not move someone with major injuries.
 Wait for the emergency medics.
- Advise medics of any known medical conditions from player's registration.
- Contact the injured person's parent/carer.
- Complete an incident/accident form. Accidents books are contained in each first aid kit and should be used to document minor injuries. Accident forms are contained in an envelope in each first aid kit and should be used for major incidents.
